

## Technical Visit to Tuen Mun Water Treatment Works cum Hydropower Plant Facilities

- Highlight of Visit:** Tuen Mun Water Treatment Works is one of the major water treatment plants in Hong Kong. It treats the raw water from the Tam Lam Chung Reservoir and supplies fresh water to Tuen Mun and Yuen Long areas. The plant had been constructed in stages since the 1970s and the last stage was commissioned in 1986 giving a total capacity of 330,000 cubic meters per day. In 2013, a hydropower plant was set up to utilise the high hydraulic head of the raw water from the Tam Lam Chung Reservoir, which generates electricity for the use of the water treatment plant.

## **Rules for the Visit to Tuen Mun Water Treatment Works cum Hydropower Plant Facilities on 25 June 2016**

1. For safety reasons of the Participants, those who require special care, who are aided by walking sticks or sit in wheelchairs, or children in prams or carried in arms are not allowed entering the waterworks installation for visit.
2. Handicapped persons must notify the event organiser for individual consideration when apply for the visit. Failing to do so will lead to the registration invalid.
3. The Participant must obey the instructions given by the working staffs of Water Supplies Department and the event organiser, and must be accompanied by the working staffs during the site visit.
4. The Participant shall enter and remain on and use the area at his/her own risk.
