## Abstract:

The Tseung Kwan O - Lam Tin Tunnel project (July 2016 to December 2022), including the Cross Bay Link, that cost more than HK&18 billion, is of no doubt a mega project. The entire projects consist of four major components sub-divided into four separated contracts, namely:

1. The main tunnel and the associated works, including the interchanging network at Lam Tin and

the 2.2km main tunnel.

- 2. Tseung Kwan O Interchange and the associated works
- 3. A carriageway network connecting Tseung Kwan O Interchange into Tiu Keng Leng local roadways.
- 4. The Tseung Kwan O Cross Bay Link.

The speaker, Ir Raymond Wong, has followed these projects since the commencement of the contracts. He has witnessed the construction of the works down to almost every single meter of this highway complex. Devil is in the Details. Base on sharing of his experience through his own eye, let's see how Raymond unveils the interesting story behind from a construction and engineering prospective.
