Speaker Highlights

Mr. Jack Guan (MSFE, Member of APEGS (Canada), Committee of SFE HK Chapter)

- The Mandatory Building Inspection Scheme (MBIS) and the Mandatory Window Inspection Scheme (MWIS) have been enforced in Hong Kong by the building authorities.
- Test method ASTM C1392 Standard Guide for Evaluating Failure of Structural Sealant Glazing cannot help the Registered Inspector to determine the factor of safety of the sealant on the old buildings because it is not a destructive test.
- Site deglazing test and H-piece tensile test based on modified ASTM C1135
 Standard Test Method for Determining Tensile Adhesion Properties of Structural
 Sealants should be adopted as test method for the evaluation process.
